

### **Instructions for contribution of cases for PG Quiz MAPCON 2016.**

Dear colleagues,

I am eagerly looking forward to the overwhelming participation from all the institutes for this year's PG quiz of MAPCON 2016.

I am sure; all the esteemed Institutes will be the enthusiastic partners of this process and make it an enjoyable academic journey.

Let me share the structure with you all –

1. Every Institute can submit maximum of two cases.
2. One case will be selected from each institute.
3. The case should have Classic Morphologic features in the form of Gross/ histology/cytology/ hematology.
4. The cases can be of infective, neoplastic or degenerative pathology from varied organ systems.
5. Initially only images should be sent for 2 cases, from which, considering the contributions from different institutes, the moderator will select a case, considering the maximum coverage of different organ systems and pathological processes.
6. Depending on the above logic, moderator may select both the cases from one Institute.
7. The images for screening in jpg format, with short clinical details are to be sent to the mail id [drkalpanaketankulkarni@gmail.com](mailto:drkalpanaketankulkarni@gmail.com) by **15<sup>th</sup> June 2016**.
8. Selection will be finalized and communicated by **25<sup>th</sup> June 2015**.
9. For selected cases, PPT 1 (Power Point Presentation 1) - Question, PPT 2 – Answer are required to be submitted on the e-mail Id given above, by **15<sup>th</sup> July, 2016**. The format for the PPT will be uploaded soon on the website.
